November 18, 2010  
Legislative Report

1. One lawsuit has been filed challenging the Governor's veto of AB 3632. At least ten counties are expected to file suit in the coming days. We will report to you on the status of the lawsuits.
2. The final language of the 1115 waiver renewal was expected to be made public on October 29, 30, or 31. However, the deadline was extended an additional five days on October 29. We will report to you on the final terms and conditions that were accepted by CMS.
3. A new Legislature convenes the first Monday of December to elect the officers of both houses and for new members to take the oath of office. In addition, a new Governor will be elected on November 2. We will report to you what implications the election has for mental health.
4. Congress has a lame duck session on November 15. We will report to you if any legislation being considered impacts mental health.
